**Seward Highway Milepost (MP) 105-107
Windy Corner**

Project Goal

To reconstruct Seward Highway from milepost 105 to 107 to address long-standing safety concerns by realigning the road and railway to meet current design standards and constructing recreational/parking areas.

Current Status

The project design, environmental documentation, and permitting efforts are on-going. Recent milestones include:

- An independent analysis from Granite Construction of material source and transportation costs. A summary memorandum and a copy of the independent analysis are available for public review on the project website.
- Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) in progress and scheduled for public review and comment in Summer 2019.
- Wetlands permitting nearly complete pending United States Army Corps of Engineers approval of mitigation.
- Completion of the Municipality of Anchorage Context Sensitive Solutions review with appearances in front of the Planning and Zoning and Urban Design Commissions.

Funding

The proposed project is being completed using a combination of state and federal funding and is being developed in accordance with Federal Highway Administration guidelines.
